

Cost Estimates for Care at Overlake Surgery Center

Under the law, health care providers are required to give **patients who don't have insurance or who are not using insurance** an estimate of their bill for medical items and services.

- If you are uninsured or not using insurance, you have the right to receive an estimate of the total expected cost of any non-emergency items or services. This includes related costs like medical tests, prescription drugs, equipment, and hospital fees.
- We will provide you with an estimate at least one business day before your services are scheduled to occur. You can also ask us, and any other provider you choose, for an estimate before you schedule an item or service.
- The estimate is not a guarantee of what you may be charged.
- Make sure to save a copy or picture of your estimate.
